

NRC Rimfire Benchrest Match

Match Overview:

The Match is a Benchrest competition for scoped .22 caliber rimfire rifles using the US Benchrest (USBR) target shot at 50 yards.



SCHEDULE:

The range opens at 9:00AM. Shooters should arrive by 9:00AM for target setup and check in. Firing starts at 10:00AM. Shooters will complete all stages per instruction below.

RULES:

All shooting is single shot, slow fire, approximately two shots per minute. All firing will be from 50 yards, sitting at a bench.

COURSE OF FIRE:

- Two USBR 50 Yard targets consisting of twenty five (25) bulls will be shot back to back in 45 minutes. This includes time for shooting the sighter bulls.
- 50 rounds are required for shooting two targets with additional rounds recommended for sighters.
- It is highly recommended that a Competitor's rifle be pre-sighted in at 50 yards preferably with the same ammo that will be shot in the Match.
- Targets will be marked as #1 & #2 and will be hung next to each other using the Match provided target boards over the assigned bench number with target #1 on top.
- Ten points are awarded for hitting the center target ring, and then a descending number of points in each of the six outer rings. Eliminating the ten ring is designated as an "X" and will be used for tie breakers.
- The "Best Edge Scoring" method will be used which is based on where the bullet touches the inner ring.
- Competitors will score their own targets and each target must also be checked and initialed or signed by another Competitor.

BENCHES:

Shooters may shoot from either prone or bench positions.

RIFLES:

Any rifle in any configuration is fine as long as its in 22 rimfire caliber. Scopes, 22 magnum, bi-pods, rifle rests are all good. Basically bring what you have.
